examinations by the end-user. These recommendations only apply to the product mentioned in the safety data sheet. When mixing with other substances or under conditions deviant from norm EN 374 a manufacturer of CE-approved gloves should be referred to. The selection of the suitable gloves does not only depend on the material, but also on further marks of quality and varies from manufacturer to manufacturer. As the product is a preparation of several substances, the resistance of the glove material cannot be calculated in advance and has

therefore to be checked prior to the application.
