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SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1 Description of first aid measures

After inhalation:

Purified wax, or wax containing no oil, has such a low vapour pressure even in its liquefied state that the inhalation of toxicologically relevant components is practically impossible.

After skin contact:

Contact with the molten product may cause burns. Cool immediately with cold water, treat the wound with a sterile dressing if necessary, and seek medical attention.

Absorption of components of the paraffin mixture through the skin when handling solid wax is not expected.

After eye contact:

Rinse thoroughly with plenty of water, seek medical attention (if the wax is hot).

If swallowed:

Rinse mouth – no further action required.

Waxes can be used as ingredients in pharmaceuticals and foodstuffs, so the question of whether small amounts are absorbed from the digestive tract following accidental ingestion is irrelevant.
